Center High Families,

Center High School is offering Summer School classes **starting June 1**st – **June 30th** on a first come, first served basis for current CHS students who need to make up credits for courses they have failed. **On-line applications, through Google forms will be available by April 15, 2021.** If a student in unsure what he/she needs, then email their counselor for clarification.

ENRICHMENT/ELECTIVE CLASSES – In Person

On site, summer school enrichment/elective classes will be elective credits only, will begin June 1st and end June 30th. Classes will be Monday through Thursdays (18 days total) and each class is tentatively scheduled to run from 9:00-9:50am, 10:00-10:50am, and 11:00-11:50am. Students in any combination of taking and passing one enrichment/elective class will receive 2 credits, two classes receive 3 ½ credits and three classes receive 5 credits. An example of these would be Intramurals(PE), Drama, Band, Choir based on student need or interest.

EDGENUITY CLASSES – On-site (Library)

Edgenuity is a core class credit recovery program (ex: English, math, social science). Students will only be enrolled in classes they have previously failed. Your counselor can let you know what classes you are eligible to take. Classes will begin June 1st and end June 30th. Classes will be Monday through Thursdays (18 days total) and class is tentatively scheduled to run from 9:00 to 10:50am. In order to take a 2nd class, the first class must be completed in 2 weeks. This will require consistent work throughout each week to also include communication as deemed necessary by their instructor. Students who do not complete any work by June 2, 2021 will be dropped. In order to receive a passing score and earn credits, students must complete 85% of the expected work with at least 60% accuracy.

Note that these classes whether for Edgenuity or Enrichment are for graduation credit only (pass/fail) and do not fulfill A-G requirements.

Edgenuity students may only take one class at a time. If you pass one class by June 15, 2021 you may contact the principal or summer school secretary to enroll in a second class. The summer school secretary will notify you when you are enrolled in a 2nd class.

ENROLLMENT

When students are officially enrolled the summer school secretary or Principal will call with confirmation. A waiting list (if necessary) will be generated and for those students who were enrolled but do not show up on day one will be

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dropped. The next available student will be called, but must show up, attend, and complete all remaining classes to receive credit. No waiting list student will be called after the second day of instruction.

EXPECTATIONS

Summer school adheres to strict policies regarding attendance (no more than one absence), behavior (zero tolerance), and participation requirements (full).

TRANSPORTATION

Busing will only be available before the first (9:00am) and after the last (11:50am) scheduled classes of each day. Busing schedules TBA.
