

Good Morning Center High School Families and Friends,

Yesterday, on 12/15/2020, I sent an email to all CHS families stating that the end of the first semester is this Friday, December 18, 2020, and that the deadline for teachers to report 1st semester grades has been extended from January 5th to the 22nd. Postponing the deadline for teachers to report grades has caused some confusion and lead some people to think that it means there is an extension of the first semester and that students would have more time to submit work. I apologize for that confusion. All student work must still be completed on time and the first semester will still end this Friday. The extension of the grade reporting window is intended to allow site leadership time to discuss how we might make accommodations or modifications to the grading policies to best reflect student achievement during a first semester that is anything but traditional.
