- Thursday (12/17), only 5th and 6th periods will meet with 5th period starting at 9:00 AM and 6th period at 10:00.
- Friday (12/18), only 7th and 8th periods will meet with 7th period starting at 9:00 AM and 8th period at 10:00.
- Lunch will be available for students from 11:00 to 12:00 every day.
